**Travel and Training Grant**

### **Purpose**

To provide assistance to individuals who have limited opportunities for traveling to competitions/trainings. Athletes should be training to increase the **level of performance** and should demonstrate **financial need**.

## Criteria

1. Must be a member of one or more of the following AFSS Provincial Associations:
  - Alberta Black Powder Association
  - Alberta Frontier Shootists Society
  - Alberta Handgun Association
  - Alberta International Skeet Shooting Association
  - Alberta International Trapshooting Association
  - Alberta Metallic Silhouette Association
  - Alberta Sporting Clays Association
  - Alberta Smallbore Rifle Association
  - Alberta Skeet Shooting Association
  - Alberta Provincial Rifle Association Full Bore
  - International Practical Shooting Confederation – Alberta
2. Members of the Association may not be funded through any other sources (i.e. Sport Canada, the SFC or Alberta Foundation funding).
3. Events must be attended within the Province of Alberta.

### **APPLICATION DEADLINES DECEMBER 1<sup>st</sup> FOR THE 2020 GRANT YEAR**

The AFSS Executive will review and put forth any awards that warrant recognition.

## Eligibility

To be eligible for an athlete award an individual must:

1. Be a resident of Alberta.
2. Be a member in good standing of one or more of the Associations listed above.
3. List matches he/she is planning to attend (include dates, competition name and location).
4. Explain how the funding will be used.
